The Apuldram Centre is a rural day centre on the outskirts of Chichester, offering a range of adult social care activities that enable us to support adults with learning disabilities.





Here are some of the projects for which we are seeking funding:

Sensory Room £5,000

We plan to create a sensory room and equip it with items and equipment that appeal to all senses and which will offer a stimulating and calm environment.

Individual equipment examples are: mirror balls £110; fibre optic lights £700; sensory projector £570.

Gardening Equipment £2,000

Our trainees plant, cultivate and pick an array of organic vegetables and fruits. We wish to replace old and ageing gardening equipment and purchase new tools to enable adults with reduced mobility to participate in gardening.

Examples include: easy-pull wheelbarrows £100; easy-grip garden tools £10 each; long-reach rakes £20; garden spades £25.

Digital Technology £5,000

Our trainees need the skills to live in the digital age and utilise the opportunities that technology brings. We wish to purchase iPads, protective cases and charging units.

Examples include; iPads £400 each, heavy duty iPad cases £45 each and iPad charging trolley £1,000.



Barn redevelopment £600,000

The barn will be transformed from a cold and dark agricultural building into a thriving environment that will have three dedicated workshops and a learning space, toilet and kitchen facilities and an upper floor mezzanine.



Shop and Café £350,000

We want more people to visit our onsite shop and enjoy our home baked breads, cakes, savouries and soups. To do this we need to replace the existing temporary structure, increase our indoor seating and general in-store capacity.



Hall and Common Room £350,000

Our 8-acre site near Chichester Harbour provides a unique outdoor environment for our trainees throughout the warmer weather. We need to increase and upgrade our indoor capacity to ensure that we have facilities fit for all seasons.
